## THE MAY CROWNING



*Our Lady:* "I am Mother of the world! Come to Me for I will comfort you."

June 18, 1970

Our Lady - "I now dispense upon these Sacred Grounds the power from the Father for conversion and cure. All in the plan of Heaven for the construction of an oasis in the dark times. **My Shrine shall be called "Our Lady of the Roses, Mary, Help of Mothers."** Mar. 24 1973

### SHRINE SUNDAY HOLY HOURS

*Our Lady:* "I wish that there be held on these Sacred Grounds an hour of reparation on the Day of the Lord [Sunday]. This hour will be for your Vicar and the fallen hierarchy in the House of God. This hour will also be in atonement for the discard of the Holy Day of God." Sept. 14, 1972

### A Future Sanctuary, Basilica & Spring

*Our Lady:* "One day, My child, the waters will come up at Bayside, and I will appear over the old Church building. **Your Bishop then cannot deny My appearances.**" May 17, 1986.

Our Lady "There will be established in your country a refuge, a sanctuary. You will be guided, My child and My children, to this sanctuary. **The Basilica shall be built on the sacred grounds.** Patience and fortitude will win you your crowns." Dec. 31, 1974

*Our Lady:* "Yes, there is a **spring** upon the grounds; of **waters for cure.** When the time is right, the Eternal Father shall bring the waters up." Feb.10, 1976

**Our Lady requests three hour Rosary Vigils on the Eve of the Feast days (7pm-10pm) and Sunday Holy Hours for our clergy and hierarchy (10:30am Sundays)**

**Shrine Vigils** –three hours of ‘*prayer of atonement*’7-10pm on the Eve of the Feast Days. See our Vigil Calendar.

*The Vigil means to keep watch and in religious to have religious service on the eve – vigil of a feast. It consists of 7 Rosaries, Litanies, Hymns and concluding candlelight prayer at the conclusion to ‘bring in the new feast day.’*

Our Lady promised She would ‘*guide us on the eve of all the feast days.*’

**Rosary Processions** – Our Lady requests ‘mittens’ – white gloves be worn during the processions. Our Lady’s statue is carried 3 times around the Shrine with the people in procession following praying the Rosary

**Shrine Holy Hour** on Sundays at 10:30am to 12:00pm – 3 Rosaries (15 decades), litanies and hymns.

## SHRINE ROSARY VIGILS

*Our Lady:* **"My rosary will be the light of the World."**

July 1, 1970

Our Lady - "I now dispense upon these Sacred Grounds the power from the Father for conversion and cure. All in the plan of Heaven for the construction of an oasis in the dark times. **My Shrine shall be called "Our Lady of the Roses, Mary, Help of Mothers."**

"Come to Me all mothers who weep for their children. Come to Me and I will solace you. Understanding pours forth from My Mother's heart. Come, and I will place My mantle upon you, and you will find great comfort with Me.

"Many mothers shall stand in great trial in the days ahead. Satan will enter upon many homes, and parents will be placed upon the cross.

"I will always be here waiting for you. There is no time in Heaven. Therefore, there is no calculation of time upon My Sacred Grounds. I am always here. **During the vigils of eves of feast days, We ask for special gatherings for the propagation of the Message to go throughout the world. However, We ask all to come here without this special purpose, but to accept the graces that We will dispense henceforth in abundance.**"  
March 24, 1973

**BERETS AT THE SHRINE:** Our Lady requested Blue Berets for Women and White Berets with 'Michael' imprinted for Men.

**Modesty in Church and at the Shrine** in respect in honor of God's House and the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, and others.

Men and women are asked to dress with modesty with loose-fitting clothing, no transparent fabrics and avoiding low cut necklines and cut off slacks or sleeves. Women are asked to wear a skirt or dress to the knees and wear and to have a head covering: beret, hat, mantilla, or, scarf, etc. Men are to dress modestly with long pants and shirt.

## Vigils of prayer and meditation

*Our Lady:* **"You must make it known that this is a Vigil of prayer and meditation. ....** This site [Flushing Meadows] and the Sacred Grounds, [Bayside] My child, are Centers of Atonement." Nov 1, 1975

*Our Lady:* "Your bishops and your cardinals need prayers. There must be hours of atonement and sacrifice for them. I have called to you to come onto the grounds of My Shrine site in Bayside, and **I have directed you to maintain these prayer hours upon these grounds [Flushing Meadows] for your cardinals and bishops.**" May 28, 1977

**The Site of the Vatican Pavilion Site in Flushing Meadows Park (temporary Vigil site from 1975 to present)**

*Our Lady* - "My child and My children, now continue with your prayers of atonement; **We are not leaving. My Son and I will be upon the grounds until the last person leaves. And should anyone come here to pray during the weekdays before the Vigils or the Holy Hours, We will come.**" ....

*Our Lady* - "Yes, My child, one day these grounds [Flushing Meadows] also will be renowned. These grounds shall be a holy place of visitation, as shall also be the Shrine at Bayside." September 27, 1986

*Our Lady* - **"The world can only find redemption and peace with the graces from Heaven. My children, maintain a constant vigil of prayer."** October 6, 1970

**'Sacred Grounds Open in Perpetuity'**

*Our Lady:* "You will continue with the prayers of atonement. **I will be with you always on these Sacred Grounds.** Though I have asked for dates for special Vigils, this does not mean that the grounds will not be open in perpetuity." March 25, 1973

## Begin the Vigil & Holy Hour:

**St. Michael Prayer** (*sprinkle holy water*)

(the highest Archangel in Heaven, who said "*who is like unto God?*") and cast Lucifer out of Heaven who had defied God.

**Prayer:**

**St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray. And do thou O Prince of the Heaven Host. By the Divine Power of God, cast into hell satan and all the evil spirits who wander throughout the world seeking the ruin of souls.**

**Act of Contrition and 3 Hail Mary prayers** for anyone who has died without the final act of contrition.

(requested by Our Lady when on the Sacred Grounds)

## **An Offering of the Holy Hour for Priests**

**Opening Prayer at the Sunday Holy Hours at Our Lady of the Roses Shrine in Flushing Meadows Park, Queens, NY**

O my God, poor weak and miserable as I am, I have come to spend this hour alone with You, in reparation for the priests who have forgotten that they are Your chosen souls. Especially, dear God, do I offer this Holy Hour for the priest who at this moment needs it most. In praying for consecrated souls, help me to remember my own utter weakness, misery and nothingness. Were it not for Your grace, I would be far worse than those for whom I pray.

O my God, help those priests who are faithful to remain faithful; to those who are falling, stretch forth Your divine hand that they may grasp it as their support. And for those poor unfortunate souls who have fallen, lift them up in the great ocean of Your mercy, that being engulfed therein, they may receive the grace to return to Your great loving Heart. Amen.

## *The Holy Rosary*

Begin with holding the Crucifix and bless yourself saying:

In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen



## **THE CREED**

I BELIEVE IN GOD, the Father the Almighty, creator of Heaven and earth. **On first large Bead** , say one Our Father; then on the three small Beads -say a Hail Mary on each

**On the Joyful Rosary on the first three Hail Mary substitute say the Acts of Faith Hope and Love** after the Our Father on the first three Hail Mary beads.

**The Act of Faith**

"O my God, I firmly believe that Thou art one God in three Divine Persons, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. I believe that Thy Divine Son became man, and died for our sins, and that He shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Ghost, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins and the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen."

### **The Act of Hope**

"O my God, relying on Thy infinite goodness and promises, I hope to obtain the pardon of my sins with the help of Thy grace, and life everlasting, through the merits of Jesus Christ, my Lord and my Redeemer. Amen."

### **The Act of Charity**

"O my God, I love Thee above all things, with my whole heart and soul, because Thou art all good and deserving of all my love. I love my neighbor as myself for the love of Thee. I forgive all who have injured me, and ask pardon of all whom I have injured. Amen."

Continue stating the Mystery for each decade and the prayers for each of the 5 decades

**Every Decade of the Rosary consists of 1 Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's, 1 Glory Be,**

After each decade say these prayers - requested by Our Lady of the Roses, say the **Fatima prayer:**

"O My Jesus, forgive us our sins. Save us from the fires of hell. Lead all souls into heaven, especially those in most need of Thy Mercy." then say the **St. Michael Prayer.**

The Raccolta 447 A plenary indulgence once a month on the usual conditions. If this prayer is repeated daily. (S.P. Ap. Nov. 12, 1932)

**At the end of the Rosary – Conclude with other Fatima Prayer**

**Holding the Crucifix on the Rosary then conclude with the Hail Holy Queen**

(after 5 decades of a Mystery) **Say the Hail Holy Queen** also known as the Salve Regina in Latin.

**Hail Holy Queen,** Mother of Mercy. Our life our sweetness and our hope. To thee do we cry poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious Advocate, Thine eyes of mercy toward us; and after this our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of Thy womb Jesus. O Clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.

V: Pray for us O holy Mother of God

R: That we may be worthy of the promises of Christ.

**Let us pray** God, whose only begotten Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, by His life, death and resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life. Grant we beseech Thee, that meditating upon these mysteries, of the most Holy Rosary, of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain, and obtain what they promise through he same Christ our Lord. Our Lady requested Rosary vigils beginning June 18, 1970 at the original Shrine Sacred Grounds chosen by Our Lady at the site of the old St. Robert Bellarmine Church in Bayside Hills, New York . Our Lady requests the Vigils be conducted by the clergy on the eve of the feast days and promised that a fountain, spring of curative waters will erupt at this Her chosen site. Our Lady requests also that a Basilica be built there by the local bishop (Diocese of Brooklyn) on this Her chosen site She calls the Sacred Grounds.

In May 1975, to accommodate the crowds, the Shrine Vigils and Sunday Holy Hours were relocated temporarily and continue to this day, at the Site of the Vatican Pavilion in Flushing Meadows Park, of the old World's Fair Grounds of the 1964-65 ....Our Lady approved the new site as a temporary location – calling it 'a holy site of visitation' for the future after we return to the Sacred Grounds when the Bishop receives his sign. The Vatican had a Pavilion building built and brought Michelangelo's Pieta statue for exhibition, a highlight at the World's Fair then. Pope Paul VI also visited and blessed this site on his Apostolic Visit that year. Pavilion building was later removed as with many other buildings after the Fair and a granite monument, 'exedra' was placed on this memorable and holy site now chosen by Heaven.

All messages given through Veronica from Heaven were audio-taped then printed and sent to the world. Our Lady comes as a Mediatrix between God and man.
