Original Shrine - Rosary Vigils & Holy Hours

VIGILS: on the Eve of the Feast Days-7:30pm to 10:30pm

HOLY HOURS: Sundays at 10:30am to 12:00 noon

MAY CROWNING: Sunday, May 5, 2002 10:30am

(During processions, Our Lady requests all to wear white gloves, 'mittens')

All year, in all weather conditions. Bring your rosary, a chair, clothing for outdoor weather seasons or rain; sweater, boots, rain gear blankets, umbrella, poncho as needed. Free rosary & petal for all.

SHRINE LOCATION: at the Vatican Pavilion Site, Flushing Meadows-Corona Park, Queens, NY. (borough of NY City, Diocese of Brooklyn). Site of the old World's Fair Grounds, 200yds SE of the Unisphere/Globe and just behind the Queens Theatre, adjacent to the NY Pavilion - (2 tall elevator towers with circular decks). Only 3 minutes from Shea Stadium, 10 min from LaGuardia Airport)

We invite all to come pray at Our Lady of the Roses Shrine. Save America the Rosary Way.

"The beads of prayer you will tell for three hours on the eve of all feast days - A Center of Atonement - Our Lady of the Roses, Mary Help of Mothers." Our Lady, Oct 6, 1974.

Please note that it has become necessary to alert pilgrims to locate the Shrine at the Sacred Grounds under the banner and title chosen by Our Lady, 'Our Lady of the Roses, Mary Help of Mothers.' The Shrine is not affiliated with any other groups.

DRESS CODE - Our Lady requests all pilgrims to dress appropriately, observing Christian Modesty. Men are requested to dress in modest attire with loose fitting slacks, no tank tops or shorts. Women are also asked to dress modestly in skirts or dresses with lengths to cover the knees. No revealing clothes, low necklines or see-through fabric. Also no sleeveless tops, slacks, shorts or skorts. Women are requested to have their heads covered (mantilla, beret, scarf, or hat).

Directions to the Shrine Grounds:

From all points South of New York City: Take Interstate 95 North, New Jersey Turnpike (toll Rd), to **Exit 13**, I-278, Verrazano Narrows Bridge. Follow I-278 East all the way into New York (toll bridges along route). After crossing the Verrazano Narrows Bridge, remain on I-278 East which becomes the Brooklyn Queens Expressway (BQE).

CARS: Take **Exit 39**, Grand Central Parkway/La Guardia Airport/Astoria Blvd. East. Take The Grand Central Parkway (GCP) East to **Exit 9A**, Whitestone Bridge/NY 25A East, Northern Blvd. When exiting, keep to the right following the sign for Shea Stadium. Exit at the World's Fair Marina/Shea Stadium making an immediate right (practically a U-turn) onto Stadium Rd. Follow Stadium Rd to the end. Turn right onto Perimeter Rd and follow it to the Vatican Pavilion Site. **BUSES, and Commercial vehicles** (not permitted on parkways) traveling on I-278 East, Brooklyn Queens Expressway, take **Exit 35**, I-495, Long Island Expressway. Take the Long Island Expressway East to **Exit 21**, 108 St. Turn left on 108 St. and proceed one mile to Roosevelt Ave. Make a right turn onto Roosevelt Ave. After passing 114 St., make the first right turn into Park. Turn left at stop sign and follow this road into park using the signs Theatre in the Park as a guide.

From all points West of New York City. All vehicles: Take Interstate **80 East** to the George Washington Bridge (toll bridge). After crossing the bridge using either the upper or lower level, follow signs for **I-95 North**, Cross Bronx Expressway to **Exit 6A** Whitestone Bridge/I-678 South. After **CROSSING THE WHITESTONE BRIDGE** (toll bridge) bear to the right and follow signs for I-678/Whitestone Expressway, Van Wyck Expressway. Take **Exit 13**, Grand Central Parkway/LaGuardia Airport/Triboro Bridge keeping to the far right. Take the first **Exit 25A** West - Northern Blvd. Shea Stadium. Proceed on Northern Blvd. through the first set of traffic lights, then take the next right, World's Fair Marina/Shea Stadium. Follow road at circle making the first left under the elevated highway. Shea Stadium should be directly in front of you. Turn right onto Stadium Rd, and follow it all the way down until you pass the Ice Rink & Queens Museum and go under an overpass. The New York State Pavilion is on your left. Take your next left into the park. Turn right and follow down to the Vatican Pavilion Site.

From Upstate New York: Take Interstate 87 South until it ends in New York City. **CARS:** Take I-278 West/Triboro Bridge/Long Island Exit to the Triboro Bridge (toll bridge). Cross the bridge and take the Grand Central Parkway East. Refer to directions above From all points south of New York City where it states: THE GRAND CENTRAL PARKWAY EAST. **BUSES, and Commercial vehicles** on I-87 South (not permitted on parkways) take I-95, Cross Bronx Expressway (exit is not numbered, but it follows Exit 9). Proceed on I-95 North to **Exit 6A**, Whitestone Bridge. Refer to directions above from all points West of New York City where it states: **CROSSING THE WHITESTONE BRIDGE.**

From New England: Take Interstate 95 South all the way to New York. **CARS:** Take **Exit 14**, Hutchinson Pkwy South/Whitestone Bridge. **BUSES, and Commercial vehicles** (not permitted on parkways) take **Exit 6A**, Whitestone Bridge/Bruckner Blvd. Upon exiting at **6A**, (Slow Down) You'll be making an immediate left to the Whitestone Bridge. All vehicles: Refer to directions above From all points West of New York City where it states: **CROSSING THE WHITESTONE BRIDGE.**

From the NJ - Lincoln Tunnel: Upon entry in Manhattan, turn right heading South and make a left on 34th St., crossing midtown Manhattan. Go across 2nd Ave. and take first left to the Queens-Midtown Tunnel entrance. Upon exiting take **I-495**, Long Island Expressway. **CARS:** Take **I-278 East**, Brooklyn Queens Expressway/LaGuardia Airport Exit to **Exit 39**, Grand Central Parkway/LaGuardia Airport/Astoria Blvd. East and follow signs for Grand Central Parkway East. Refer to directions above From all points south of New York City where it states: THE GRAND CENTRAL PARKWAY EAST. **BUSES, and Commercial vehicles** (not permitted on parkways) proceed on I-495, taking **Exit 21**, 108 St. Make a left turn on 108 St. and proceed one mile to Roosevelt Ave. Make a right turn onto Roosevelt Ave. After passing 114 St., make the first right turn. Follow signs Theatre in the Park. See Park Directions below.

From Long Island: Take the Long Island Expressway Interstate 495 West to **Exit 22A**, Grand Central Parkway/108 St. **CARS:** Take the Grand Central Parkway West to Exit 9P or Exit 9E Shea Stadium & turn right at Stop sign & follow Park Directions. **BUSES, and Commercial vehicles** (not permitted on parkways) when exiting at **22A** from the Long Island Expressway, must take the 108 Street Exit. At first set of lights turn right onto 108 St. and proceed one mile to Roosevelt Ave. Make a right turn onto Roosevelt Ave. After passing 114 St., make the first right turn into Park and turn left at stop sign. Follow this road down using the signs Theatre in the Park as a guide. (see Park Directions)

PARK DIRECTIONS (Flushing Meadows-Corona Park) Follow signs for Theatre/Museum. Follow Stadium-Meridian Rd down (a perimeter park road) past the Tennis Center, Queens Museum, Ice Rink, & Theatre. After the Ice Rink, go to 1st Stop sign and turn left. Go up road 100yds straight ahead & look for banner "Our Lady of the Roses" during Rosary times.

By Subway: From Grand Central Station or Times Square, take Flushing **IRT No. 7** train to last stop, Main St., Flushing. Taxi stand located on corner of Main St. and Roosevelt Ave.

Via Walking: Exit #7 Train at Willets Pt./Shea Stadium Station, one stop before Main St., and walk directly to the Vigil grounds, (15 to 20 min walk). Walk down boardwalk past Tennis Center towards the Unisphere, Ice Rink & Theatre. The Vatican Pavilion is just 50 yds past the Theatre.
