major Feast days. - 3 hour Vigils of prayer before the feast day.

“We request that all of the dedicated (clergy) join now with the faithful in prayer on these Sacred Grounds. The beads of prayer you will tell for three hours on the eve of all Feast Days.” Our Lady, October 6, 1974

The Rosary Vigils on the Eve of the Feast Days and Sunday Holy Hours requested by Our Lady are conducted throughout the year by the Official *Our Lady of the Roses* as directed by Our Lady. We await the Bishop to conduct the Church investigation & build the Basilica Our Lady requests. Bring a chair and proper clothing for outdoor weather. All are invited & will receive a rosary & rose petal and brown scapular Our Lady asked all to wear.

SHRINE LOCATION: Outdoors on the Exedra monument at the site of the former Vatican Pavilion of the old 1964-65 World's Fair Grounds, Flushing Meadows-Corona Park, Flushing, Queens, NY 11368 on Long Island, (borough of NY City, Diocese of Brooklyn).

A Greek architecture grey granite, circular monument with side pillars, 3 steps and a semi-circle wall with a bench. It is the site where the Vatican exhibited Michelangelo's Pieta sculpture of the Blessed Mother holding her crucified son, Jesus.

Pope Paul VI blessed the site in 1965 visiting the Vatican Pavilion at the Fair.

The Shrine is on Avenue of Europe off Perimeter Road by the bridge and east of the two circular NY State observation towers. The Shrine is 200yds SE of the famous steel 50ft Unisphere Globe, and 50 yards SE of the Queens Theatre just beyond their rear parking lot and right across from the new skateboard park rink. There are large evergreen bushes on either side of the Shrine exedra site. The Shrine relocated from Veronica's parish at the old St. Robert Bellarmine's Roman Catholic Church in Bayside, NY to this temporary site in May 1975 by a Court decision in Queens County. The NY City Parks Dept issues permits for Vigils.

We await the 'future Church investigation and review' as requested by Our Lady and Heaven's sign for the local bishop to build the Basilica and conduct the Vigils. A full Church investigation was never conducted by Bishop Francis Mugavero. We are loyal to the Roman Catholic Church and Holy Father and attend our local parishes.

DRESS CODE - Our Lady requests all pilgrims to dress respectfully and modestly on the Sacred Grounds - comfortable, outdoor attire for weather conditions: men with loose fitting slacks and women are asked to dress lady-like wearing a skirt or dress covering the knees (avoiding pants), with heads covered with a mantilla, beret, scarf, or hat, etc.. Please no shorts or sleeveless shirts or immodest attire.

During processions, Our Lady requests all to wear white gloves, 'mittens'

The Shrine monument is just south of the Queens Theatre which is at 14 United Nations Ave South, Flushing Meadows Corona Park, NY 11368

Follow park signs to the Queens Theatre, the closest location to the Shrine.

Brief driving to Flushing Meadows: From Triboro - RFK Bridge— exit 9E; From the Whitestone Bridge Exit 13D; or VanWyke to 12A. From the LIE/I-495, Exit 22 to the GCP west to Exit 9P. Follow the signs for the Queens Theatre in the Park..

By Train take the #7 Train to Willets Point Station and walk South past the Unisphere globe and Theatre and left of the towers and skateboard rink..


