

Veronica passed over the veil a few weeks later on August 3, 1995 and asked Arthur to continue the Mission from heaven. Veronica said to Arthur often at home, "if anything ever happens to me, I want you to continue the mission." Veronica had placed this in writing on the legal document of the Shrine Corporation papers filed in the late 1970's in the State of New York with Arthur as the 2nd officer of Our Lady of the Roses Non Profit Corp.

A photo of Mr. Arthur Lueken, Veronica Lueken's husband taken in June 1995 in front of the Unisphere built for the 1964-65 World's Fair in Flushing Meadows Park, NY. Mr. Lueken gave a talk on videotape for the Shrine's 25th anniversary explaining the early days of the mission with Veronica. Arthur met Veronica at the skating rink across from the Unisphere and near the Vatican Pavilion site where the rosary vigils are held temporarily since June 1975 from St. Robert Bellarmine Church in Bayside. The video, available at the Shrine and shown on cable stations across the country, is called "In the Beginning with Arthur Lueken". Sadly, Veronica passed away only two months later on Aug 3, 1995, after a long illness and just three months before their 50th wedding anniversary.
