# **Vigil and Holy Hour Information**

Rosary Vigils: Eves of the Church Feast Days: 7:30 to 10:30 pm.

Holy Hour: Sundays, 10:30 am for the intentions of the Pope and clergy.

Location: Vatican Pavilion: a stone monument (excedra) at old World's Fair grounds; 200 yards SE of the Unisphere and near the Queens Theatre in Flushing Meadows-Corona Park, Flushing, Queens, Long Island, N.Y. (borough of NYC & Diocese of Brooklyn). (near LaGuardia & Shea)

Shrine Grounds: outdoors in the park, all year despite weather conditions. (Bring rosary, chair, appropriate seasonal clothing for outdoor weather, blankets in winter, rain gear, etc. Eating not permitted on the Shrine grounds). Since June 18, 1970, thousands of people from all over the world have come to the Shrine to pray and receive many blessings with graces of cure and conversion. Countless miracles have been received.

Over 300 messages were transmitted during the Vigils with Veronica Lueken as the "voice-box" repeating the words from Heaven.

We invite all to come and pray at Our Lady of the Roses Shrine. Your attendance is very important. Prayer, sacrifice and atonement.

"This is a Vigil of prayer and meditation. This site [Vatican Pavilion] and the Sacred Grounds [St. Robert Bellarmine], My child, are Centers of Atonement."

(In June 1975, the vigils moved from St. Robert's in Bayside, (Veronica's parish then) to the Vatican Pavilion in Flushing Meadows Park.)

"I have asked that the Clergy, who have been given this sacred duty to the Father, preserve these Sacred Grounds as a Shrine, a center of atonement.

# **Driving Directions to the Shrine**

From all points South of New York City Take Interstate 95 North New Jersey Turnpike (toll rd.) to Exit 13, 1-27S, Verrazano Narrows Bridge. Follow 1-278 East all the way into New York (toll bridges along route). After crossing the Verrazanno Narrows Bridge, remain on 1-278 East which becomes the Brooklyn-Queens Expwy. Cars: Take Exit39, Grand Central Pkwy/LaGuardia Airport/Astoria Blvd. East. Take the Grand Central Parkway (GCP) East to Exit 9A - Whitestone Bridge/NY 25A East, Northern Blvd. When exiting, keep to the far right following sign to exit at Shea Stadium. Exit at the World's Fair Marina/Shea Stadium. Turn right at stop sign (almost a U-turn) onto Stadium Road. (Continue with Park Directions)

Buses: And Commercial vehicles (not permitted on Parkways) traveling on I-278 East, Brooklyn/Queens Expwy, take Exit 35, I-495, Long Island Expwy. Take the Long Island Expwy East to Exit 21, 108° St. Turn left onto 108th St. and proceed one mile to Roosevelt Ave. Turn right onto Roosevelt Ave. After passing 114th St., take the next right turn into the Park. Follow road to first stop sign and turn left onto Meridian Rd. (Continue with Park Directions)

From all points West of New York City. All vehicles: Take Interstate 80 East to the George Washington Bridge (toll bridge). After crossing the bridge using either the upper or lower level, follow signs for I-95 North, Cross Bronx Expwy to Exit 6A Whitestone Bridge I-678 South. After Crossing the Whitestone Bridge (toll), bear to the right and follow signs for I-678, Whitestone Expwy, Van Wyck Expwy. Take Exit 13. Grand Central Parkway/LaGuardia Airport/Triboro Bridge, keeping to the far right. Take the first exit, 25A West, Northern Blvd/Shea Stadium. Proceed on Northern Blvd. through the first traffic light take the next right turn, 'World's Fair Marina/Shea Stadium'. Go around circle to bearing left to go under the elevated hwy. Shea Stadium should be directly in front of you, turn right at stop sign. (Continue with Park Directions)

From Upstate New York Take the Interstate 87 South until it ends in New York City. Cars: Take 1-278 West/Triboro Bridge/Long Island Exit to the Triboro Bridge (toll). Cross the bridge and take the Grand Central Parkway East. Refer to directions above: From all points South of New York City where it states: The Grand Central Parkway East. Buses And commercial vehicles on I-87 South (not permitted on Parkways) take I-95, Cross Bronx Expwy (exit is not numbered, but it follows Exit 9). Proceed on I-95 North to Exit 6A, Whitestone Bridge. Refer to directions above: From all points West of NYC - Crossing the Whitestone Bridge.

From New England. Take Interstate-95 South all the way to New York. CARS: Take Exit 14, Hutchinson Pkwy South / Whitestone Bridge. Buses: And commercial vehicles (not permitted on parkways), take Exit 6A, Whitestone Bridge/Bruckner Blvd. Upon exiting 6A, slow down! Make an immediate left) to the Whitestone Bridge. All vehicles: Refer to directions above: From all points West of NYC. - Crossing the Whitestone Bridge.

From the Lincoln Tunnel. Upon entry to Manhattan, make a right turn heading south and make a left on 34th St, crossing Manhattan. Go across 2nd Ave, and take first left to the Queen's/Mid-town Tunnel entrance. After exiting (toll), take 1-495, Long Island Expwy Cars: LIE to GCP West to exit 9P OR Take 1-278 East, Brooklyn/Queen's Expwy/ LaGuardia Airport to Exit 39, Grand Central Parkway/LaGuardia /Astoria Blvd. East. Follow signs for Grand Central Parkway East. Refer to: directions above: From all points South of NYC where it states Grand Central Parkway East. Buses: and commercial vehicles (not permitted on Parkways) proceed on 1-495, taking Exit 21, 108° St. - Refer to directions above: From all points South of NYC.

From Long Island Take the Long Island Expwy, I-495 West to Exit 22A. Grand Central Parkway/108th St. Cars: Bear far right to exit on right for the Grand Central Pkwy/ Triboro Bridge. Stay on right to Park Exit 9P (open seasonally) or 9E (1/4 mile down). Turn right at stop sign and follow Meridian Rd. to Shrine. (Continue with Park Roads Directions) Buses: and commercial vehicles, when exiting at Exit 22A from 1495, must take Exit at 108th St. At traffic light, turn right onto 108th St. and proceed one mile to Roosevelt Ave. Turn right turn onto Roosevelt Ave. After passing 114th St. make the first right turn into the Park, At stop sign turn left onto Meridian Rd. (Continue with Park Directions)

PARK DIRECTIONS (Flushing Meadows-Corona Park). Follow signs for Theatre/ Museum. Follow Meridian Rd down (a perimeter park road) past the Tennis Center. Queens Museum/Ice Rink & Theatre. After the Ice Rink/Theatre turn left at 1st stop sign and follow up 100 yards to the Vatican Pavilion Site. Free Parking.

By Subway. From Grand Central Station or Times Square (42ND St. Line), take the Flushing IRT No.7 train to last stop, Main St. Flushing, Queens. Taxi stand located on corner of Main Street, and Roosevelt Ave. Via walking Exit the #7 Train at the Willets Pt./Shea Stadium station, (one stop before last stop at Main St.) Walk down boardwalk past Tennis Center, Unisphere (globe), Ice Rink, and Queens Theatre to the Vatican Pavilion on left of large circular fountain/pool. (15 to 20 min walk).
