(During processions, Our Lady requests all to wear white gloves, 'mittens')

The Rosary Vigils and Holy Hours are conducted by the original Our Lady of the Roses Shrine as directed by Our Lady to Veronica. Vigils and Holy Hours continue all year, in all weather conditions. Bring your rosary, a chair, adequate clothing for outdoor weather. Infirm area in front. All receive a free rosary & rose petal.

SHRINE LOCATION: the site of the Vatican Pavilion, Flushing Meadows-Corona Park, Queens, NY. (borough of NY City, Diocese of Brooklyn). (Near Shea Stadium, 10 min from LaGuardia Airport). Site of the old 1964 World's Fair Grounds, 200yds SE of the Unisphere/Globe and 50 yds south of the Queens Theatre, east of the two circular platform towers. Save America the Rosary Way!!

Please look for our Shrine banner, 'Our Lady of the Roses' at the Vatican Pavilion. The Shrine was relocated from the original Shrine site of St. Robert Bellarmine's old church, Bayside NY in May 1975. The NY City Dept of Parks and Recreation issues us permits to conduct the Vigils. We await the 'future Church investigation and review', and Heaven's sign for the bishop to build the Basilica & conduct the Vigils as requested by Our Lady. **Please note: The Shrine is Not affiliated with any other group, apostolate, or ministry who use our name or assemble nearby.**

DRESS CODE - Our Lady requests all pilgrims to dress modestly on the Sacred Grounds. Men are requested to dress in modest attire with loose fitting slacks. Women are asked to wear in skirts or dresses to cover the knees (avoiding pants), with heads covered with a mantilla, beret, scarf, or hat. All are asked to avoid shorts and sleeveless tank tops.

Directions to the Shrine Grounds:

From Long Island: Take the Long Island Expressway Interstate 495 West to **Exit 22A**, Grand Central Parkway/108 St. **CARS:** Take the Grand Central Parkway West to Exit 9P or Exit 9E Shea Stadium & turn right at Stop sign & follow Park Directions below. **BUSES, & Commercial vehicles** (not permitted on Parkways) when exiting at 22A from the Long Island Expressway, must take the 108th St. Exit. At the first set of lights, turn right onto **108 St.** and proceed one mile to Roosevelt Ave (under the elevated train). Turn right onto Roosevelt. After passing 114 St., take the first right turn & follow the curving road bearing right to 2nd stop sign & turn left. Go down following the Theatre signs. See Park Directions below.

From New England: Take Interstate 95 South all the way to New York. **CARS:** Take **Exit 14**, Hutchinson Pkwy South/Whitestone Bridge. **BUSES, and Commercial vehicles** (not permitted on parkways) take **Exit 6A**, Whitestone Bridge/Bruckner Blvd. Upon exiting at 6A, (Slow Down) You'll be making an immediate left to the Whitestone Bridge. All Vehicles: Refer to directions above **From all points West of New York City** where it states: CROSSING THE WHITESTONE BRIDGE.

From all points West of New York City. All Vehicles: Take Interstate **80 East** to the George Washington Bridge (toll bridge). After crossing the bridge using either the upper or lower level, follow signs for **1-95 North**, Cross Bronx Expressway to **Exit 6A** Whitestone Bridge/I-678 South. After **CROSSING THE WHITESTONE BRIDGE** (toll), stay to the right and follow signs for I-678 / Whitestone Expressway, Van Wyck Expressway. Take **Exit 13** on the far Right: **Grand Central Parkway /LaGuardia Airport/Triboro Bridge**. Take the first **Exit 25A** West - Northern Blvd./Shea Stadium. Proceed on Northern Blvd through the first set of traffic lights, then turn right at the sign, World's Fair Marina/Shea Stadium. Follow the road to the 1st intersection, (Marina piers on right) and turn left and go under the elevated highway. (Shea Stadium should be directly in front of you.) Turn right at stop on Stadium Rd. Follow road past the Stadium 1 mile. See Park Directions.

From all points South of New York City: Take Interstate 95 North, New Jersey Turnpike (toll Rd), to **Exit 13, I-278**, Verrazano Narrows Bridge. Follow I-278 East all the way into New York (toll bridges along route). After crossing the Verrazano Narrows Bridge, remain on I-278 East which becomes the Brooklyn Queens Expressway (BQE).

CARS: Take **Exit 39**, Grand Central Parkway/La Guardia Airport/Astoria Blvd. East. Take The **Grand Central Parkway (GCP) East** to **Exit 9A**, Whitestone Bridge/NY 25A East, Northern Blvd. When exiting, keep to the right following the sign for Shea Stadium. Exit at the World's Fair Marina/Shea Stadium making an immediate right at the light, (practically a U-turn) onto Stadium Rd. Follow Stadium Rd to the end. See 'Park Directions'. **BUSES, and Commercial vehicles** (not permitted on Parkways) traveling on I-278 East, Brooklyn Queens Expressway, take **Exit 35, I-495**, Long Island Expressway. Take the Long Island Expressway East to **Exit 21, 108 St.** Turn left on 108 St. and proceed one mile to Roosevelt Ave. Make a right turn onto Roosevelt Ave. After passing 114 St., take the first right turn and follow to the 2nd stop sign. Turn left toward Queens Theatre. Follow 'Park Directions' below.

From Upstate New York: Take Interstate 87 South until it ends in New York City. **CARS:** Take 1-278 West/Triboro Bridge/Long Island Exit to the Triboro Bridge (toll bridge). Cross the bridge and take the Grand Central Parkway East. Refer to directions above From all points south of New York City where it states: THE GRAND CENTRAL PARKWAY EAST. **BUSES, and Commercial vehicles** on **I-87 South** (not permitted on parkways) take **I-95**, Cross Bronx Expressway (exit is not numbered, but it follows Exit 9). Proceed on I-95 North to **Exit 6A**, Whitestone Bridge. Refer to directions above, From all points West of New York City where it states: CROSSING THE WHITESTONE BRIDGE above.

From the NJ - Lincoln Tunnel: Upon entry in Manhattan, turn right heading South and make a left on 34th St., crossing midtown Manhattan. Go across 2nd Ave. and take first left to the Queens-Midtown Tunnel entrance. Upon exiting take **I-495**, Long Island Expressway. **CARS:** Take **I-278 East**, Brooklyn Queens Expressway/LaGuardia Airport Exit to **Exit 39**, Grand Central Parkway/LaGuardia Airport/Astoria Blvd. East and follow signs for Grand Central Parkway East. Refer to directions above **From all points south of New York City** where it states: THE GRAND CENTRAL PARKWAY EAST. **BUSES, and Commercial vehicles** (not permitted on parkways) proceed on I-495, taking **Exit 21, 108 St.** Make a left turn on 108 St. and proceed one mile to Roosevelt Ave. Turn right onto Roosevelt Ave. After passing 114th St. make the first right turn into the Park. Follow the curving road to the 2nd stop sign and turn left. Follow signs toward the Theatre in the Park. See Park Directions below.

PARK DIRECTIONS (in Flushing Meadows Park) Follow signs for Queens Theatre & Museum. Follow Stadium/Meridian Rd down (a perimeter park road), past the Tennis Ctr, Museum, Ice Rink, & Theatre. After two speed bumps & an underpass, turn left at the Stop. Go up the road about 50yds past the two tall towers on the left & look for "Our Lady of the Roses" banners at the Vatican Pavilion Site. **By Subway:** From NYC 42nd St., take Flushing **No. 7** train to last stop, Main St., Flushing. A Taxi stand is on the corner of Main & Roosevelt. **Via Walking:** Exit #7 Train at Willets Pt./Shea Stadium (1 stop before Main St), & walk directly to the Shrine, (15 to 20 min). down boardwalk past the Tennis Center, the Unisphere/Globe, Ice Rink & Theatre. The Vatican Pavilion is 50 yds past left of the Queens Theatre past the lot.
