I got "Guillian-Barre" syndrome - only one in one hundred thousand get this sickness. My legs were paralyzed and my arms were becoming the same. Over three weeks in intensive care, no one knew what I had. Some of the eighteen doctors that saw me every day said I would not walk again - ever! While holding my rose petal, I said "Don't bet on it."! Today I am walking and moving my arms and hands very nicely thanks to Our Blessed Mother!

The supplies I'm ordering are going to Iraq, along with a goodie box of hand warmers, hard candy, teddy bears (to hug), note cards, Valentine stuff, to a woman, a mother of two pre - teens that works in an ER at the hospital. I sent her a scapular. She wrote back and said she already had one on her "dog - tag" ID and hoped it was ok to give it to another soldier. He was very appreciative. I have never met this woman, but I now know her. God works in mysterious ways.

I have five scapulars, four crucifixes and ten rose petals already packed up for the service men and women in Iraq!! So, Blessed Mother is going to Iraq. Please find my check enclosed. I'm glad you people, volunteers, are there! I'm grateful and am spreading the word of Our Lady since 1995. God bless, thanks.
